## THE WELCOME WE OFFER

GOOD SHEPHERD LUTHERAN CHURCH OF GILROY IS AN INCLUSIVE CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY. ST. PAUL, IN GALATIANS 3, REMINDS US THAT BAPTISM MAKES US CHILDREN OF GOD, AND THEREFORE, "THERE IS NO LONGER JEW OR GREEK, THERE IS NO LONGER SLAVE OR FREE, THERE IS NO LONGER MALE AND FEMALE; FOR ALL OF YOU ARE ONE IN CHRIST JESUS." THEREFORE, WE WELCOME PEOPLE OF ALL SEXUAL ORIENTATIONS AND GENDER IDENTITIES FULLY INTO THE LIFE OF OUR CONGREGATION.

Our Congregational Council, at our November meeting, approved this statement of welcome. The Council recommends that our congregation adopt this statement of welcome as our way of becoming a Reconciling in Christ Congregation. We will meet in January on a Sunday after worship to take up the vote. It is an important step for us to take in our witness to the expansive grace of God in our community.

For centuries, churches have more often been on the side of excluding people of non-mainstream sexual orientation and gender identities. Some have thought that a person's sexual orientation was a matter of choice. Some have thought that only people who follow "nature's order" are worthy of God. Some have cited selected Bible verses as proof of God's disfavor of people who are different from most of us. The "Us vs. Them" thinking has hurt many faithful, baptized Christian people who find themselves left out.

My father, may he rest in peace, had a strong bias against gay and lesbian people. Then I told him about Glen, whom my Dad knew. Glen worked for the church at large in the area of youth leadership. Glen was a dedicated man who gave generously of his time and talent and treasure to the work of the church. My Dad didn't know Glen was gay until I told him. I said that Glen was baptized as an infant before he became aware of his sexual orientation at adolescence, but that his baptism still counted. We in the church cannot all of a sudden exclude people like Glen because he happens to be gay. He is not a criminal, he is not a pedophile, he is a good man who was wired to like men. My Dad changed his mind.

Many of us, including myself, have made something of the same kind of discovery about someone we have come to know and love as a fellow Christian, as a human being. We have had to overcome the social stigma about people who are "other" than ourselves. We have learned through scientific studies that sexual orientation and gender identity are not life-style choices that people make, but that people just come that way. We have come to learn that almost everyone knows someone who is gay, and that knowing such a person makes all the difference. People of different sexual orientation and gender identity are saints and sinners, like all of us. They have mothers and fathers and siblings. They have jobs and pay their taxes and are good neighbors. They sing in church choirs and teach Sunday school.

A Reconciling in Christ congregation believes that God's love is bigger than any thing that would keep us from being reconciled to one another. That means we welcome all people. We have been welcomed and received by God through the reconciling work of Jesus. He says to us, "as the Father has sent me, so I send you." By adopting our statement of welcome, we become the only church in south county to directly and clearly and overtly welcome people who have been left out and have felt rejected. This is truly who we are; nothing about us changes. We are simply making it known: This is God's work, our hands.



## **Advent Is Filled With Hope**


